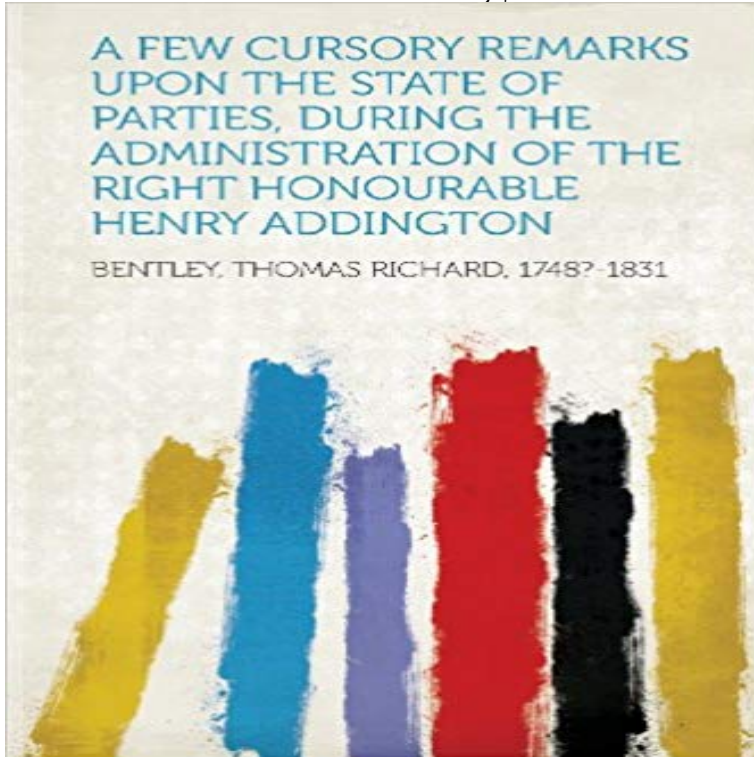


A Few Cursory Remarks Upon the State of Parties, During the Administration of the Right Honourable Henry Addington
