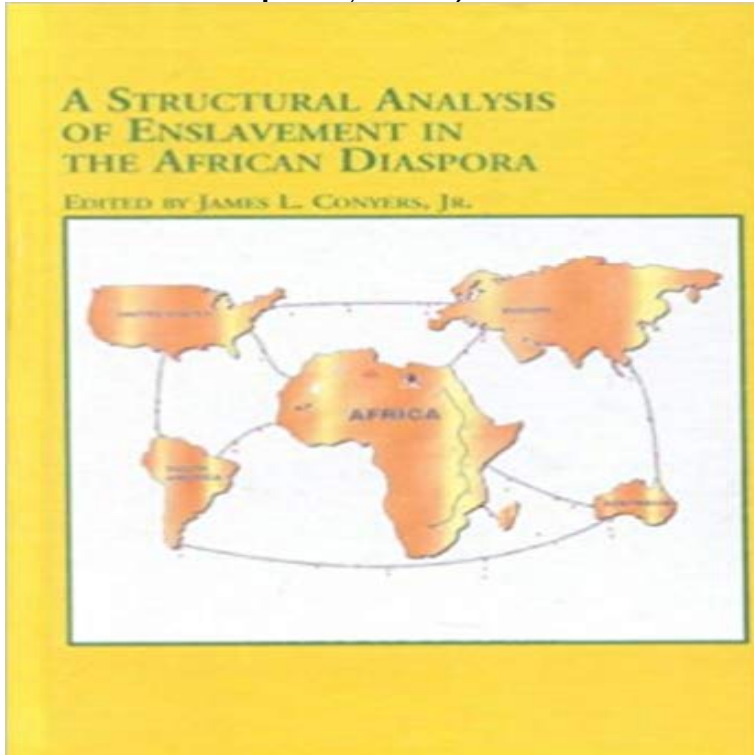


A Structural Analysis of Enslavement in the African Diaspora (Studies in African Diaspora, V. 1)
