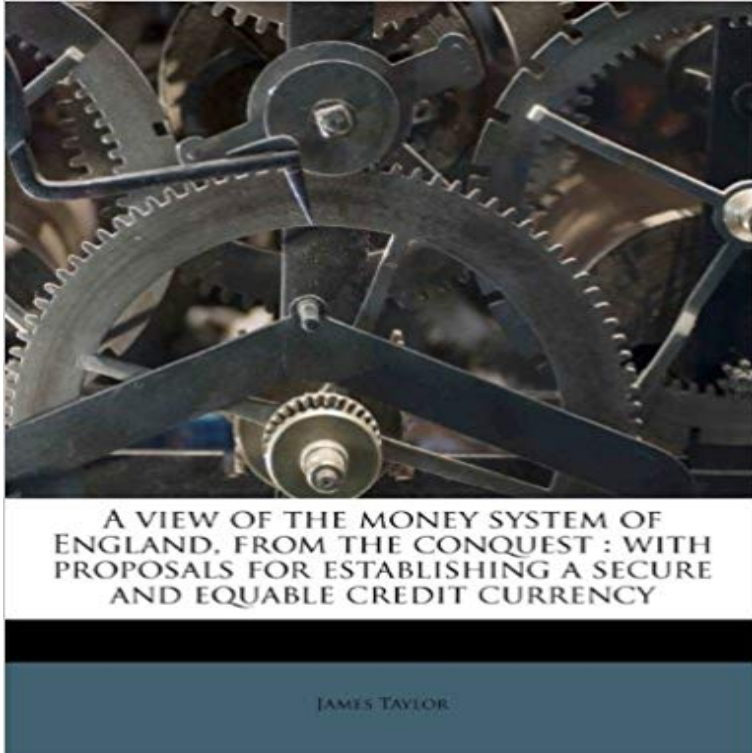


A view of the money system of England, from the conquest: with proposals for establishing a secure and equable credit currency
