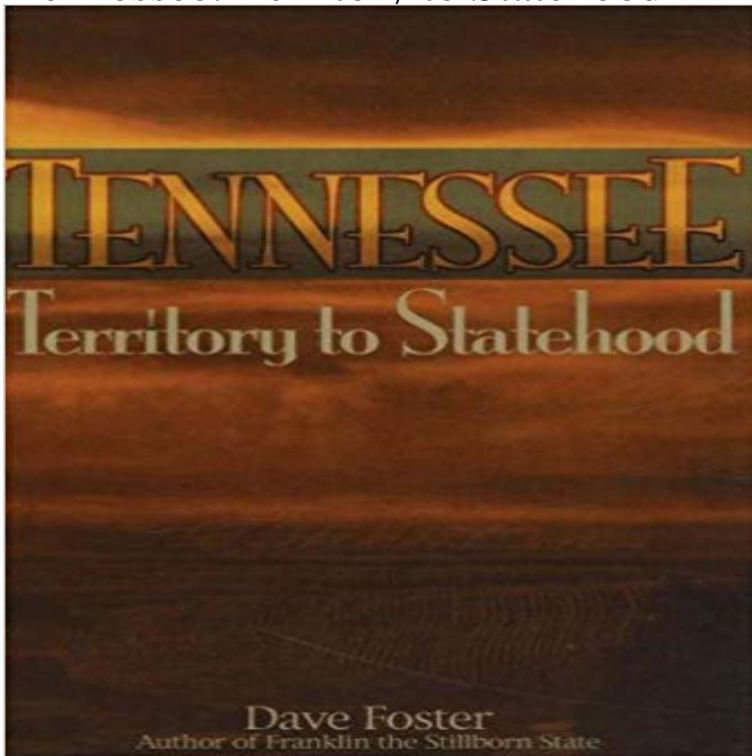


## Tennessee: Territory to Statehood
