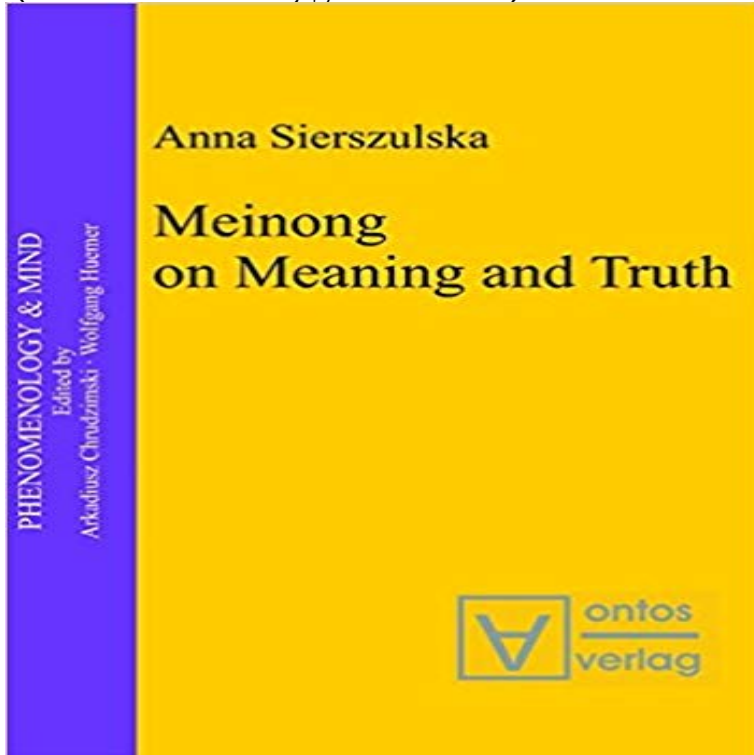


Meinong on Meaning and Truth: A Theory of Knowledge (Phenomenology & Mind)



The study aims at exposing Meinongs ideas that may be of interest to analytic philosophers. It contains all the basic information concerning Meinongs theory of objects with a special focus upon objectives, which are Meinongs propositions. An outline of his conception of truth, which is classified as firmly realistic, is followed by a review of the critical works touching upon Meinongs epistemological ideas. Finally, Meinongs theory of objects is presented as inspiring the development of Meinongian logics, with his Aussersein as the prototype of an all-inclusive semantic domain. The issues considered include reference of terms and sentences as well as the general features of a Meinongian-style semantics.
