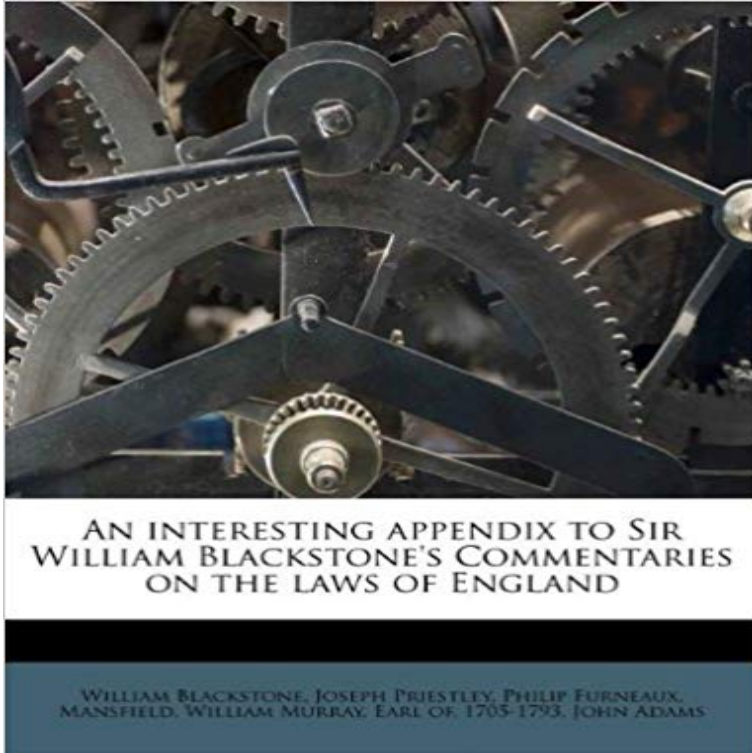


An interesting appendix to Sir William Blackstones Commentaries on the laws of England
