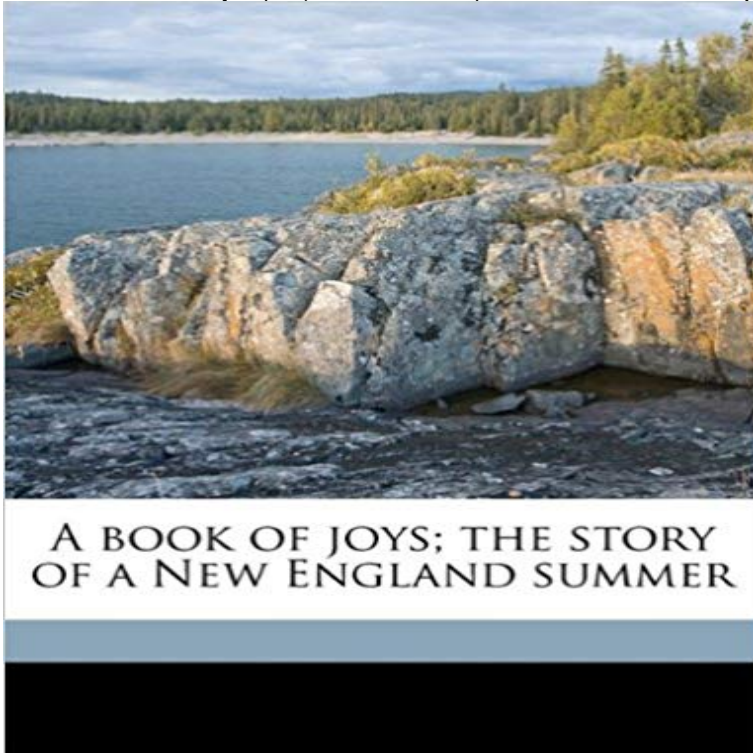


A book of joys; the story of a New England summer
