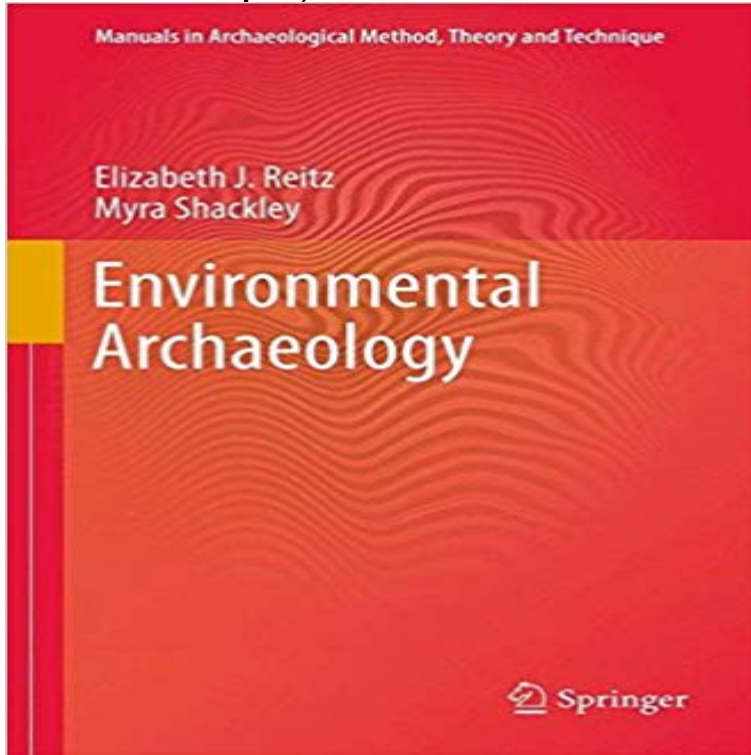


Environmental Archaeology (Manuals in Archaeological Method, Theory and Technique)
