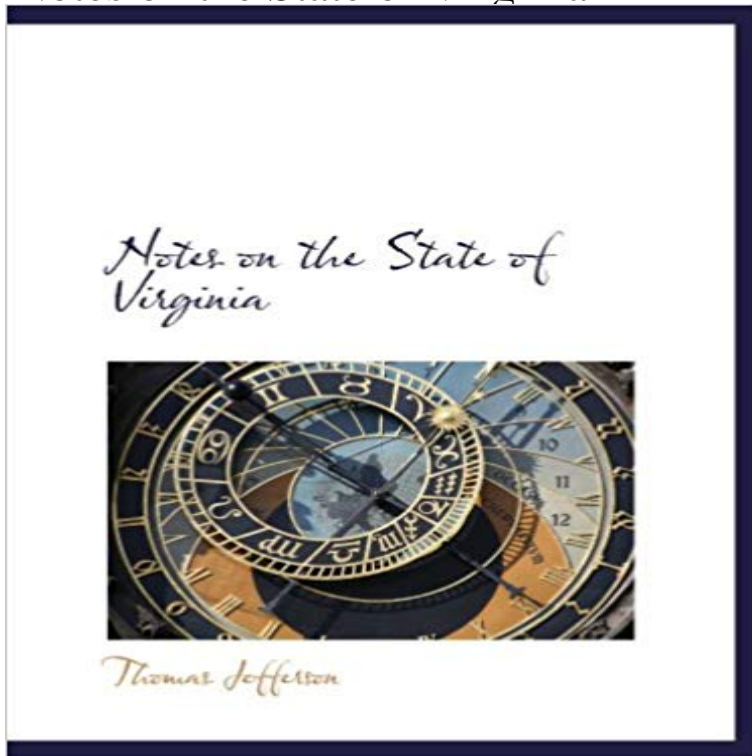


Notes on the State of Virginia
