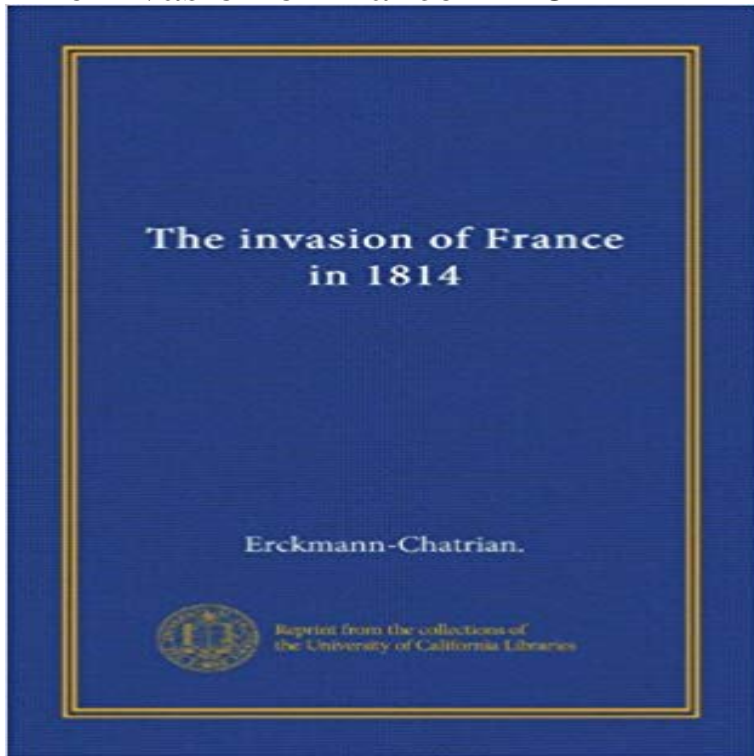


The invasion of France in 1814
