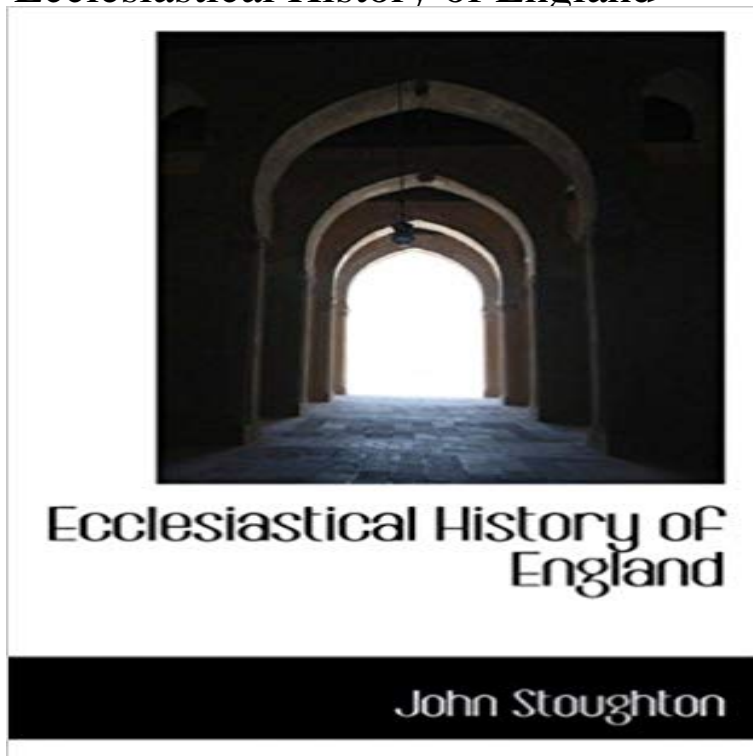


## Ecclesiastical History of England
