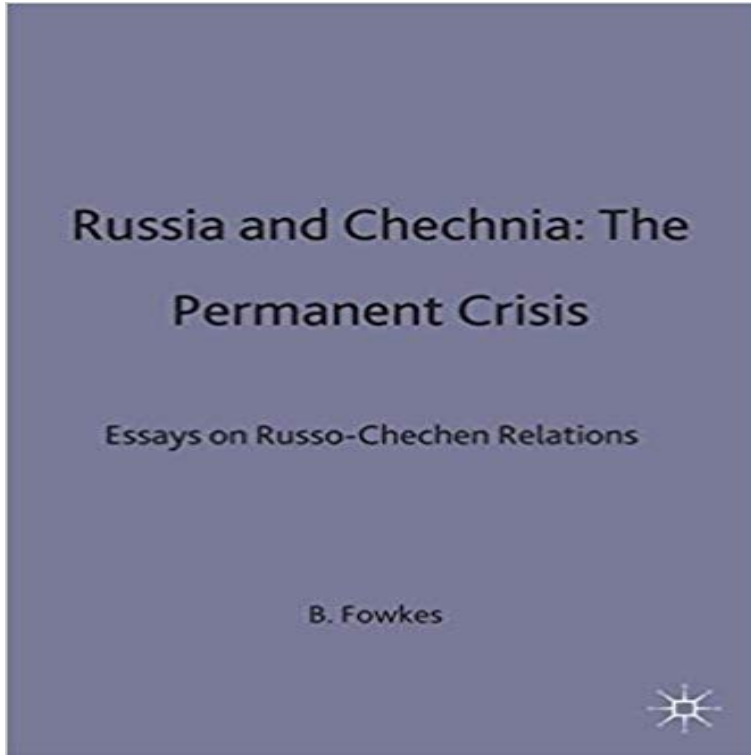


# Russia and Chechnia: The Permanent Crisis: Essays on Russo-Chechen Relations
