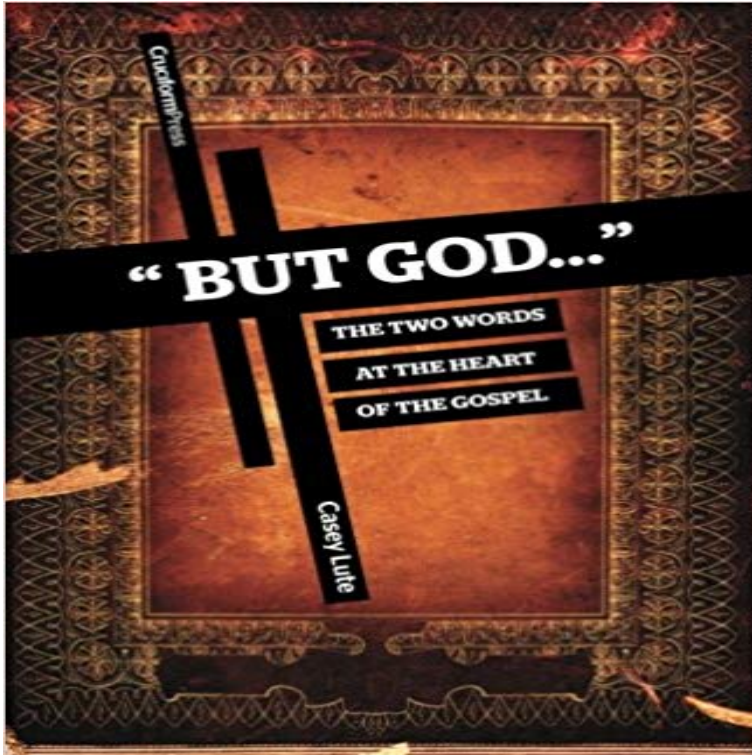


But God...: The Two Words at the Heart of the Gospel

It also teaches us of the potential consequences if God were not to act.
