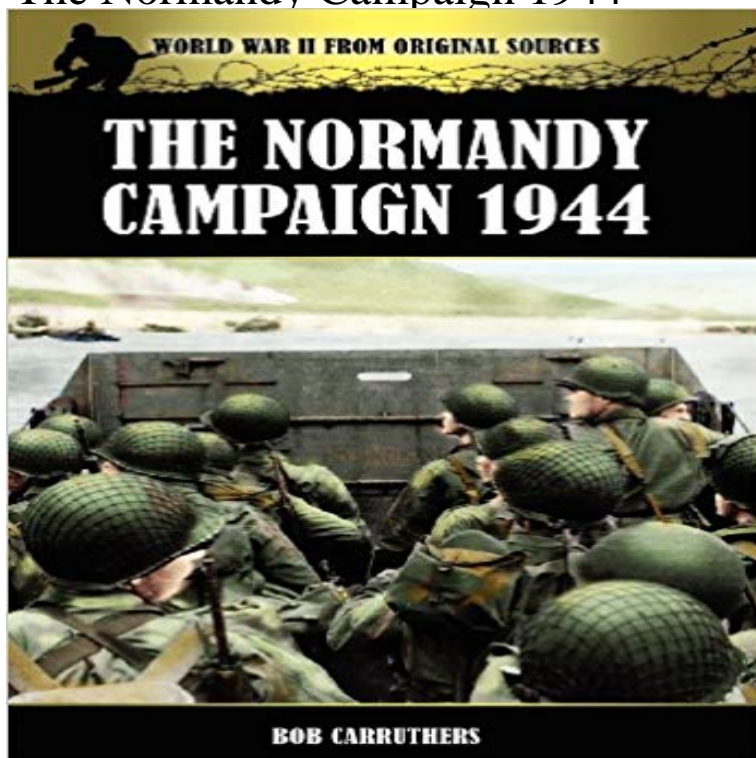


The Normandy Campaign 1944
