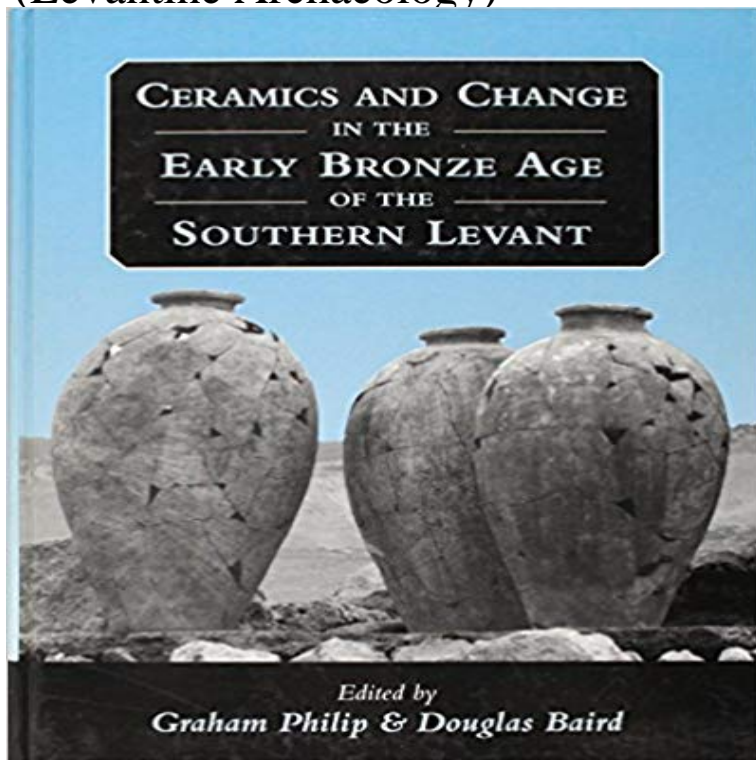


Ceramics and Change in the Early Bronze Age of the Southern Levant (Levantine Archaeology)
