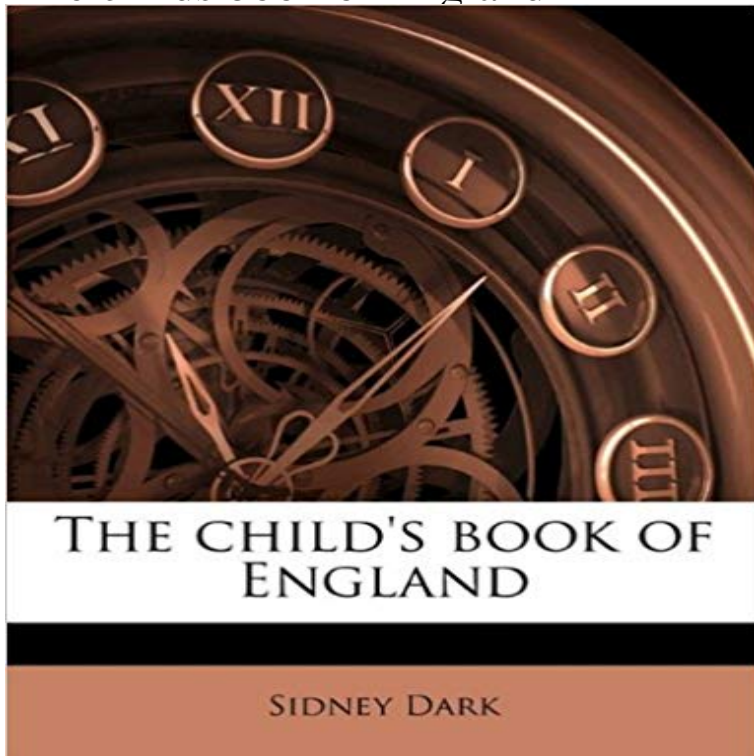


The child's book of England
