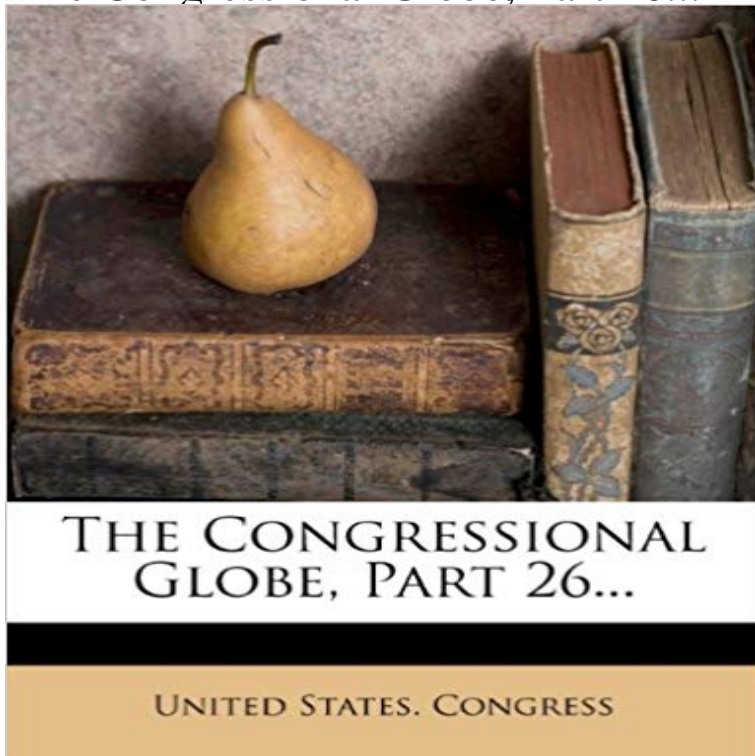


## The Congressional Globe, Part 26...
