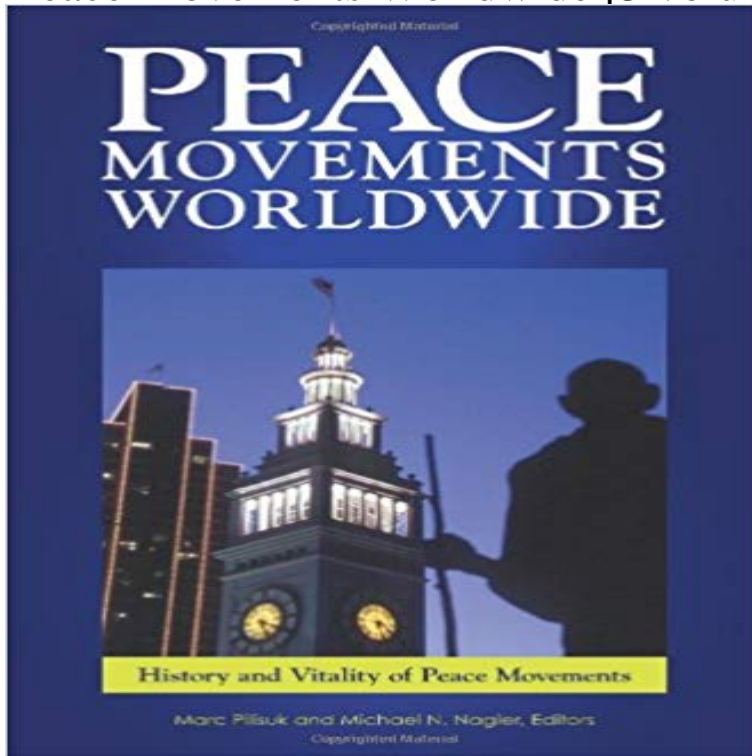


Peace Movements Worldwide [3 volumes] (Contemporary Psychology)
