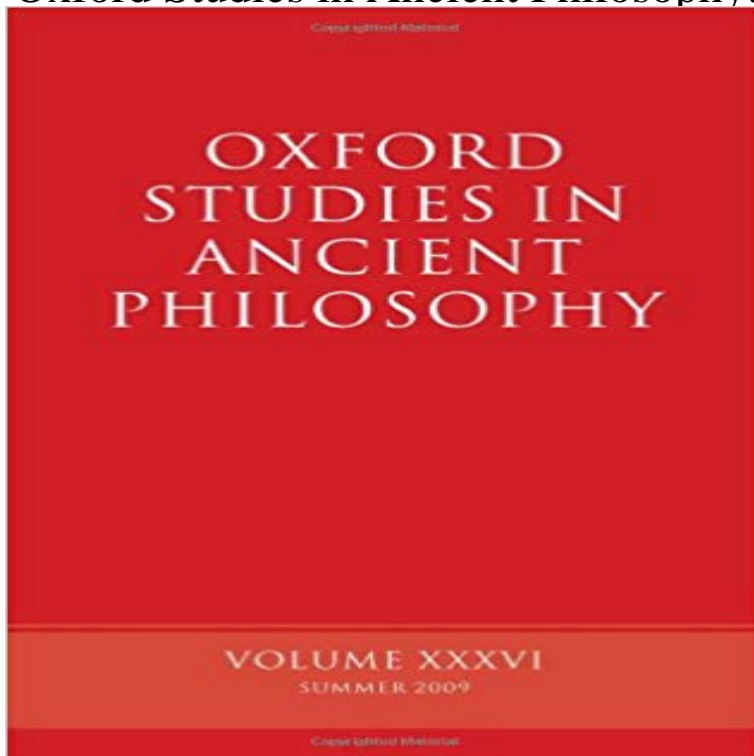


## Oxford Studies in Ancient Philosophy: Volume 36 (v. 36)
