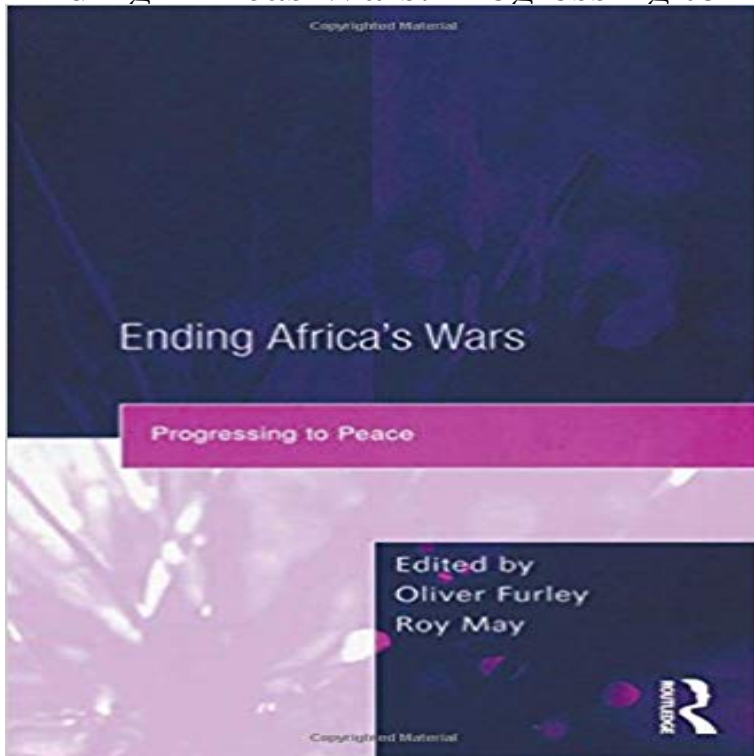


Ending Africas Wars: Progressing to Peace
