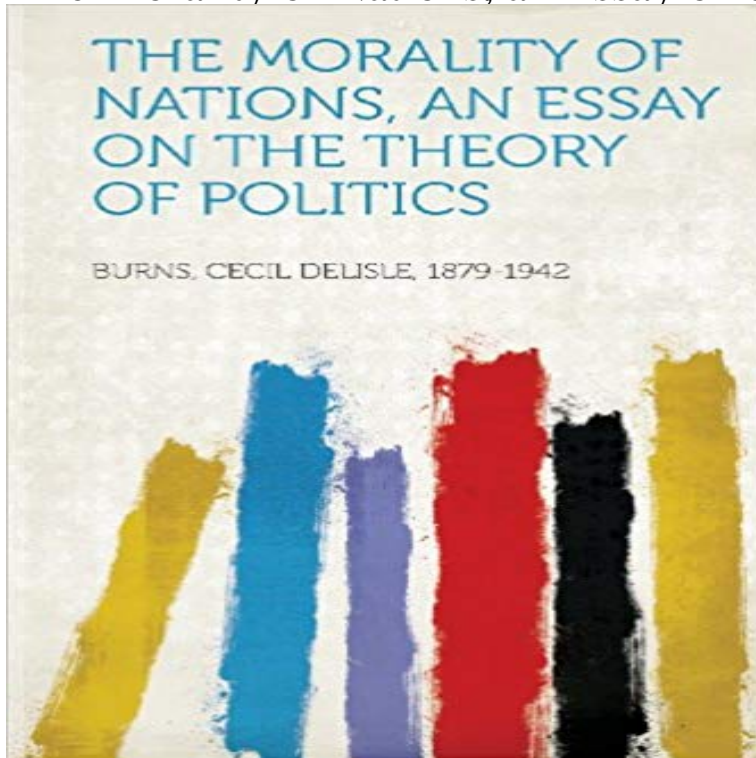


The Morality of Nations, an Essay on the Theory of Politics
