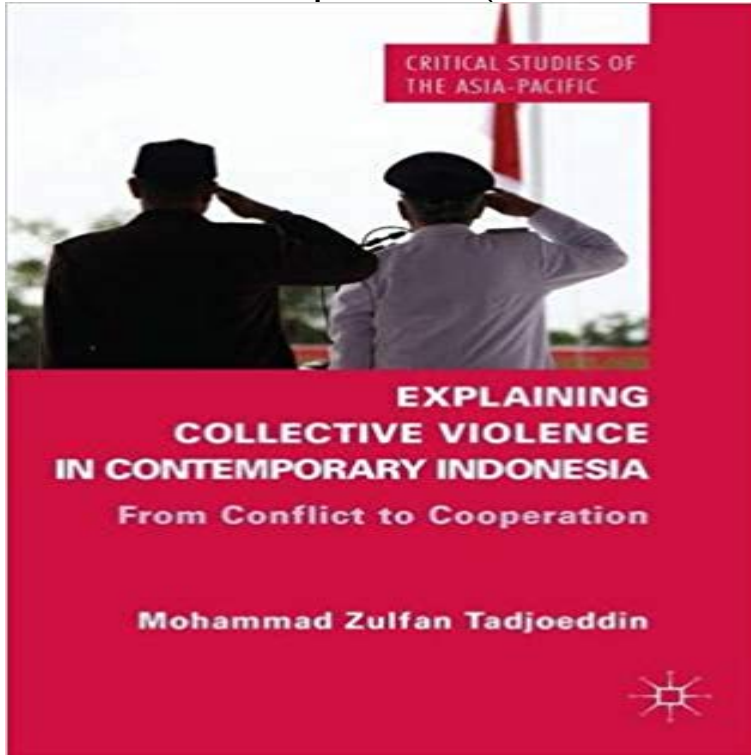


Explaining Collective Violence in Contemporary Indonesia: From Conflict to Cooperation (Critical Studies of the Asia-Pacific)
