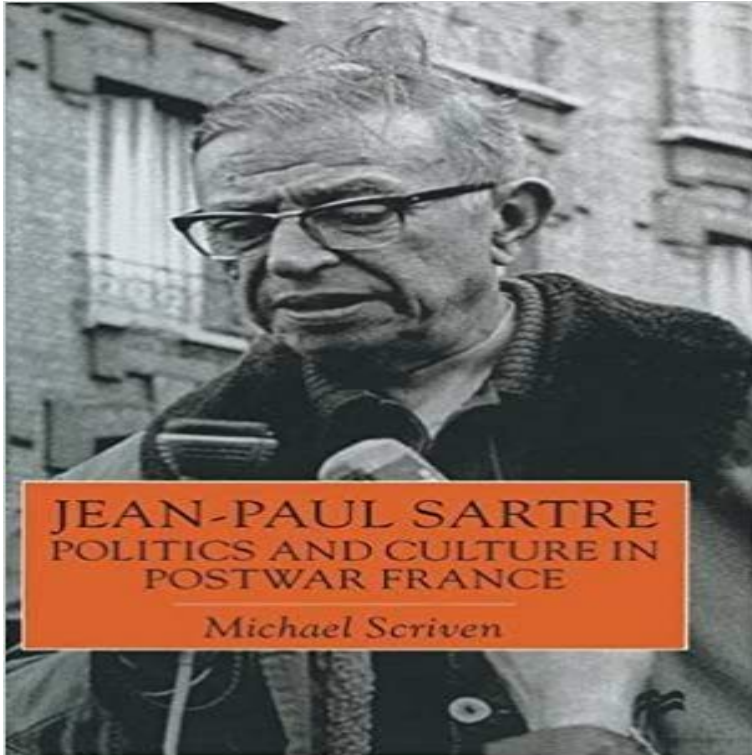


Jean-Paul Sartre: Politics and Culture in Postwar France
