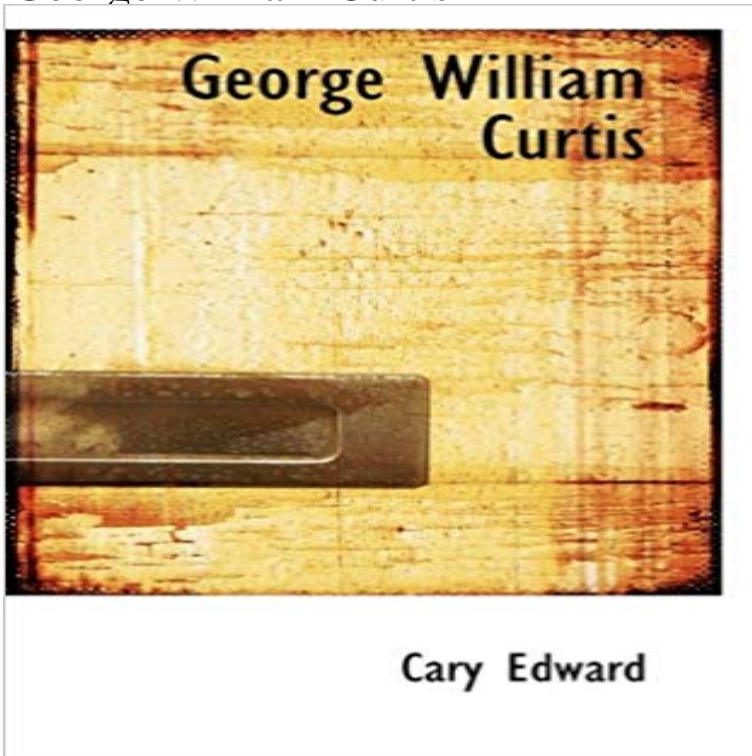


George William Curtis
