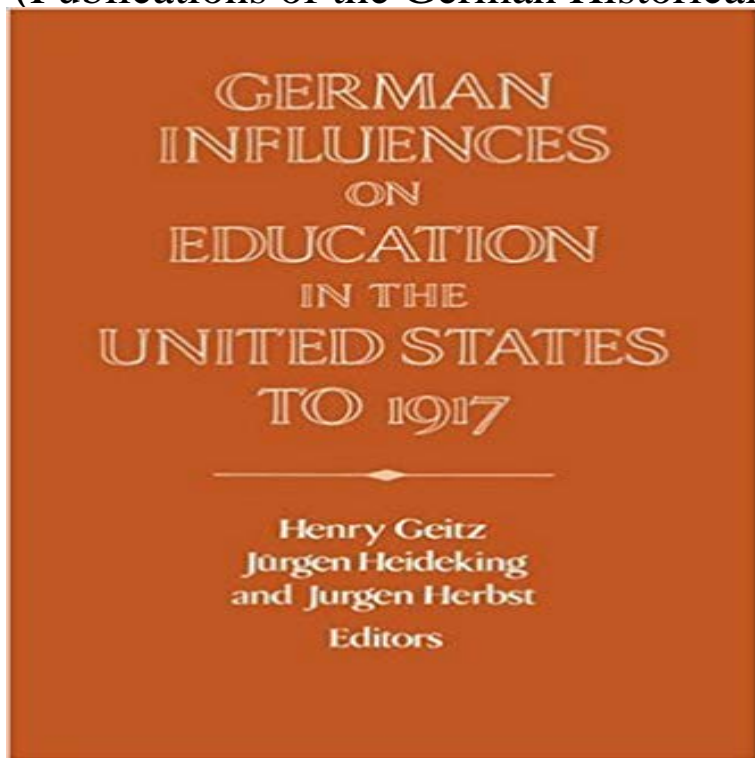


German Influences on Education in the United States to 1917 (Publications of the German Historical Institute)
