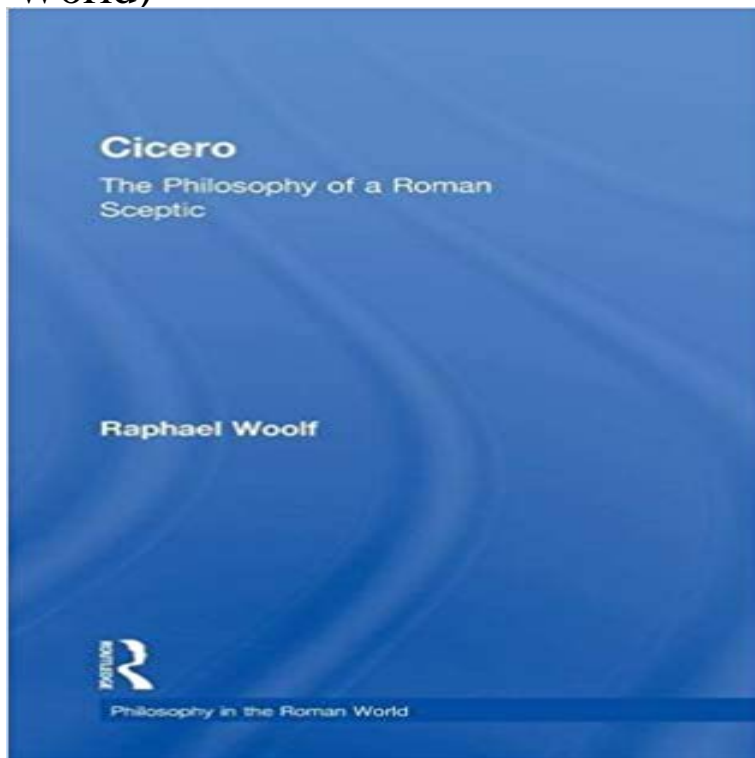


Cicero: The Philosophy of a Roman Sceptic (Philosophy in the Roman World)
