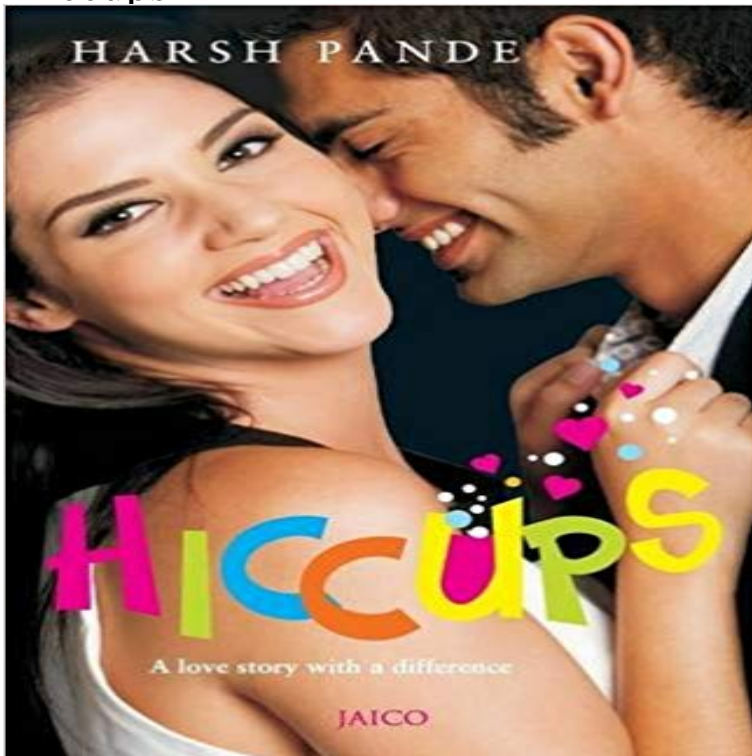


# Hiccups
