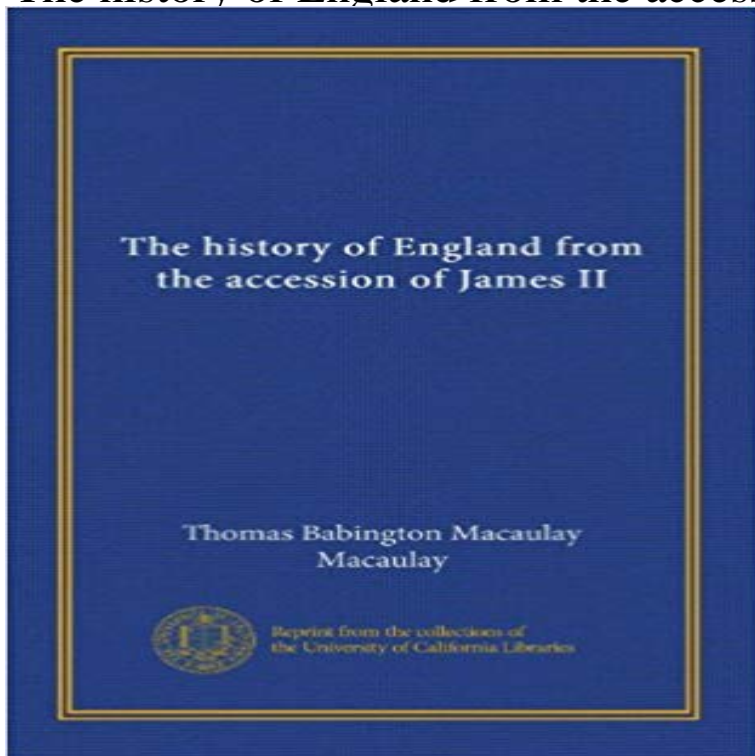


The history of England from the accession of James II (v.4)
