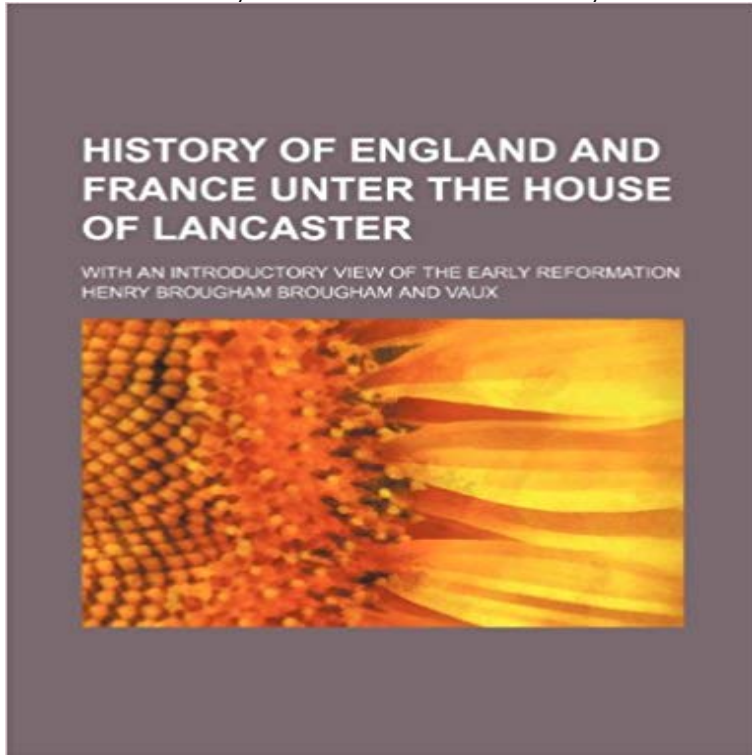

Two remarkable illustrations of this danger have been afforded in the history of England, the one a century, the other half a century ago. After Walpoles truly wise administration had preserved the peace of the country at home and abroad, as well as its free government, for twenty years, he was reluctantly driven into hostilities with Spain by a war-whoop which his adversaries raised for merely factious purposes; they afterwards admitted to Mr. Burke that they had not the shadow of a case against Spain or against Walpole; they acted entirely through the clamour of the ignorant multitude. Again, in 1803, the clamour of the country, acting through, and excited by the Press in the attacks upon Napoleon, if it did not occasion, certainly hastened the war which raged for eleven
