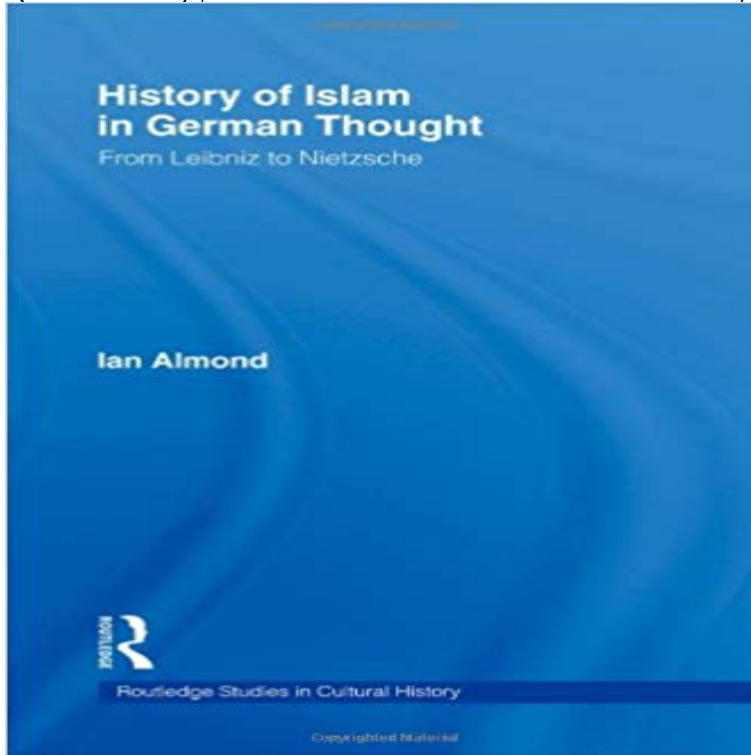


History of Islam in German Thought: From Leibniz to Nietzsche (Routledge Studies in Cultural History)

Exploring a variety of neat compartmentalizations at work in the representations of Islam, as well as distinct vocabularies employed by these key intellectuals (theological, political, philological, poetic), Ian Almond parses these vocabularies to examine the importance of Islam in the very history of German thought. Almond further demonstrates the ways in which German philosophers such as Hegel, Kant, and Marx repeatedly ignored information about the Muslim world that did not harmonize with the particular landscapes they were trying to paint a fact which in turn makes us reflect on what it means when a society possesses knowledge of a foreign culture.
