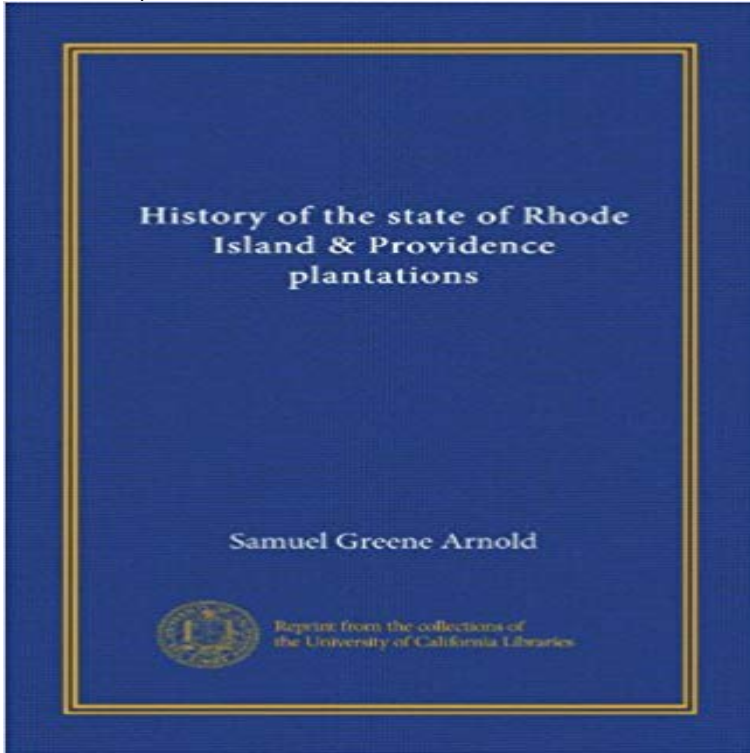


History of the state of Rhode Island & Providence plantations (v.1)
