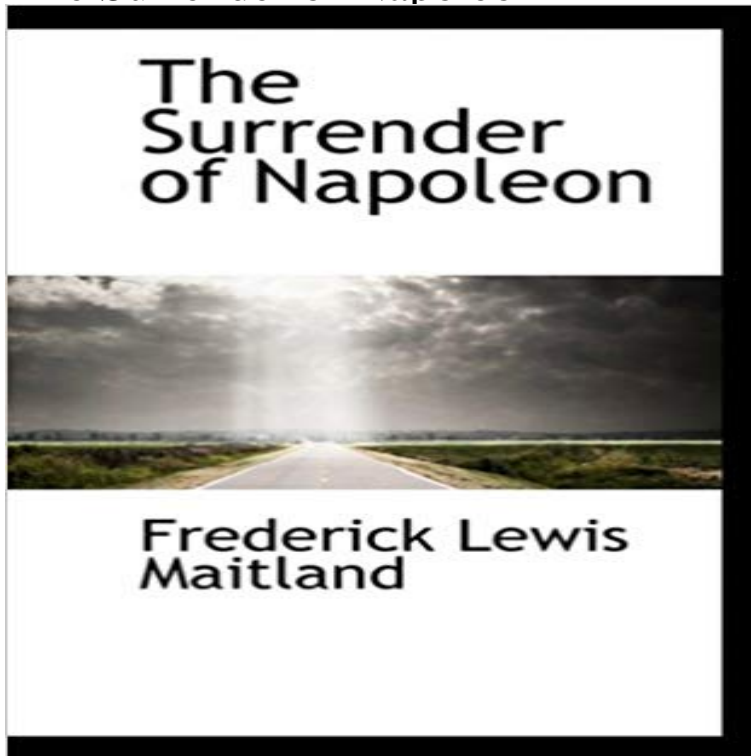


The Surrender of Napoleon
