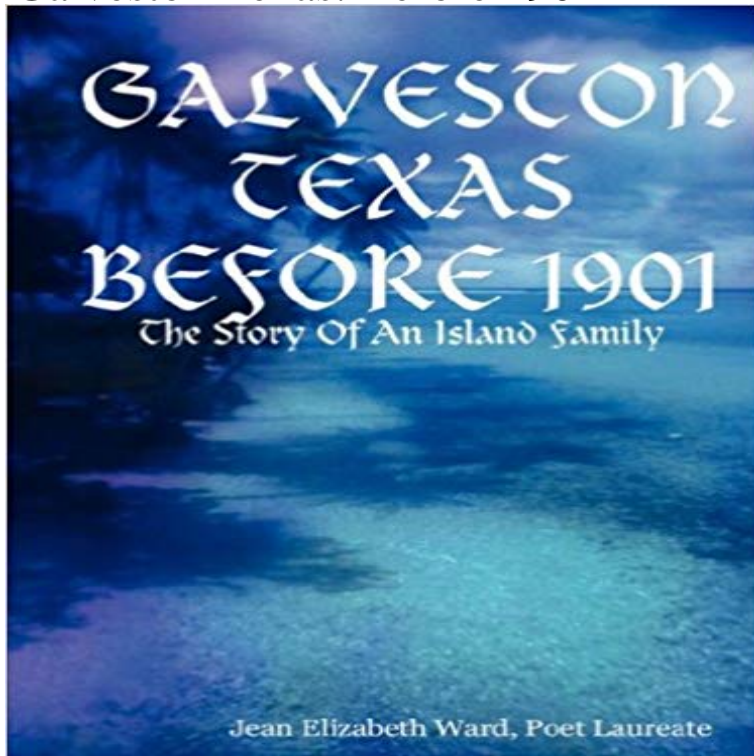


Galveston Texas: Before 1901
