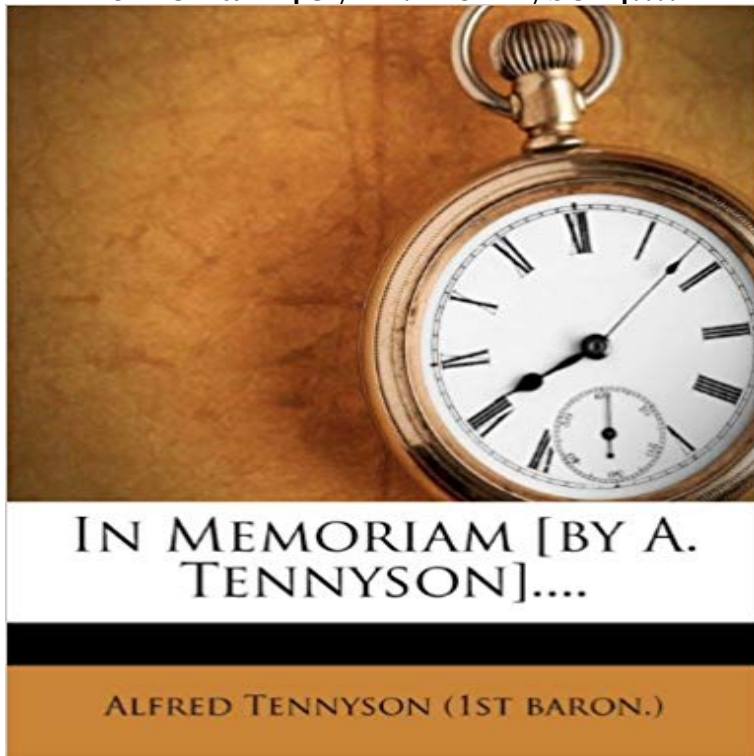


## In Memoriam [by A. Tennyson]....
