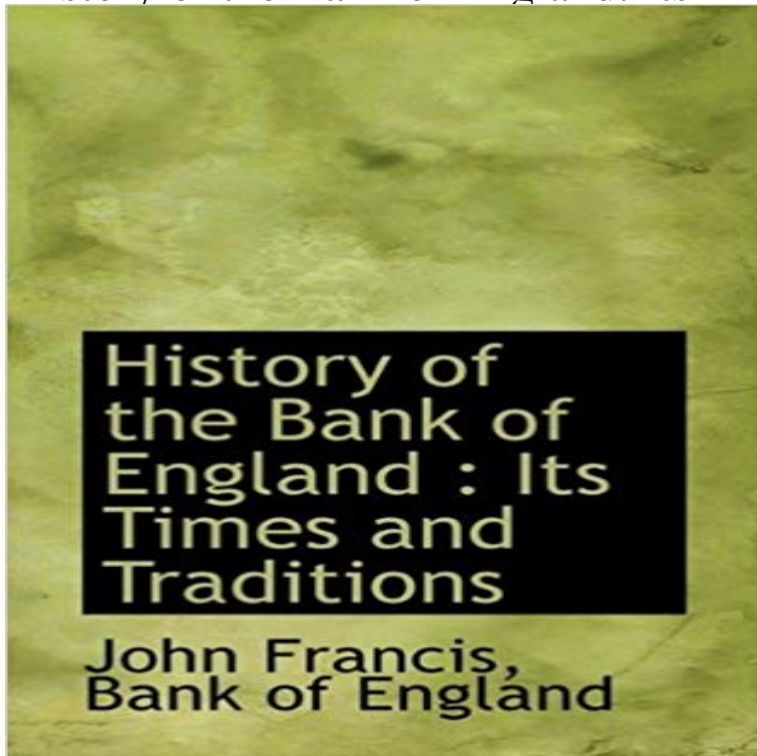


# History of the Bank of England: Its Times and Traditions
