
Irregular Migrants: Policy, Politics, Motives and Everyday Lives (Ethnic and Racial Studies)

In this situation undocumented migrants, especially in relation to immigration controls and internal security have come to occupy an important role on the policy agenda of many nation states. The control and regulation of undocumented migrants has become an increasingly politicised issue.
