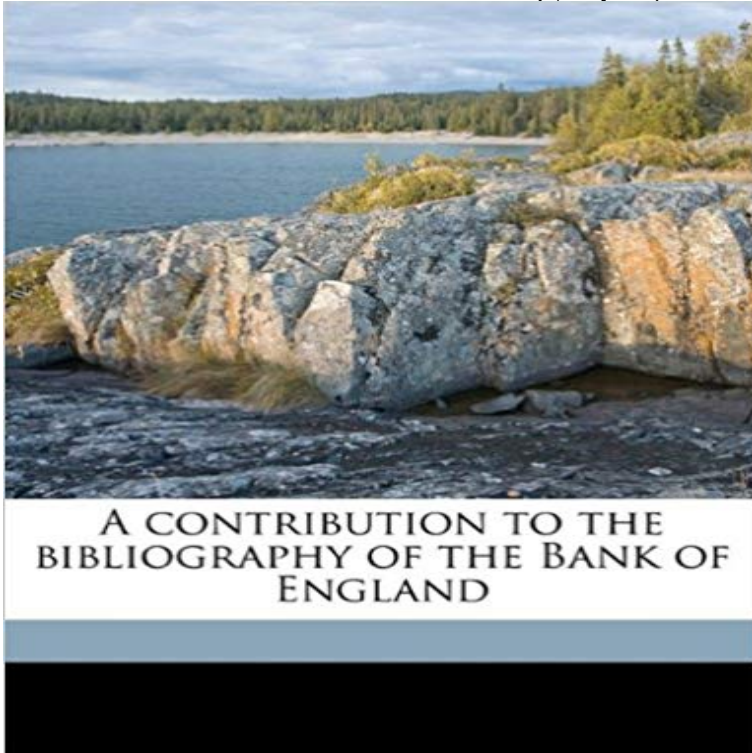


A contribution to the bibliography of the Bank of England
