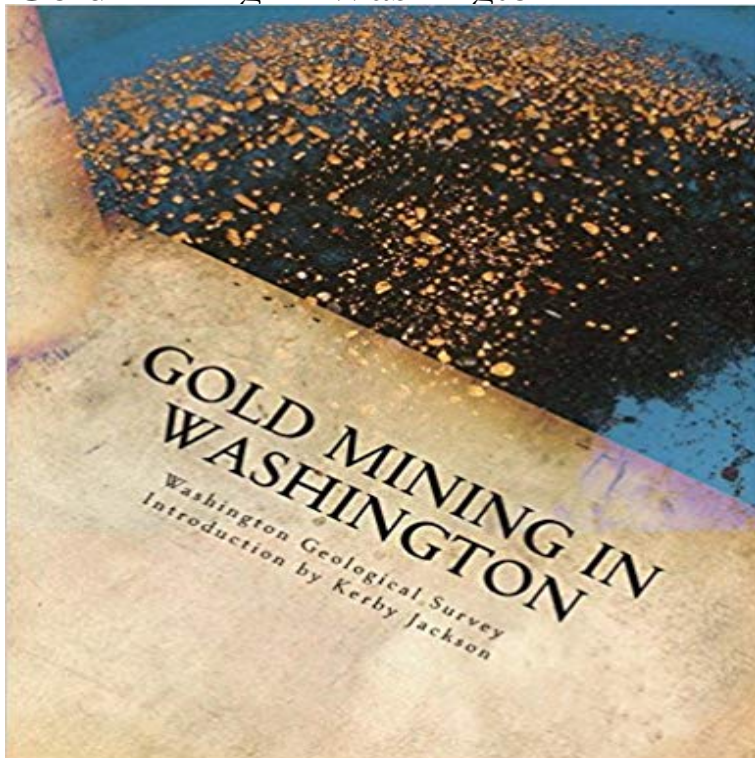


Gold Mining in Washington
