

On the morrow, at six oclock in the morning, Joyces troopers were grouped in battle-array in the courtyard; Mr. Joyce, said the king, appearing upon the steps, by what authority do you intend to take me from here? Sire, by the authority of the army, to prevent the designs of its enemies, who would once more plunge the kingdom in blood. That is not a legal authority.
