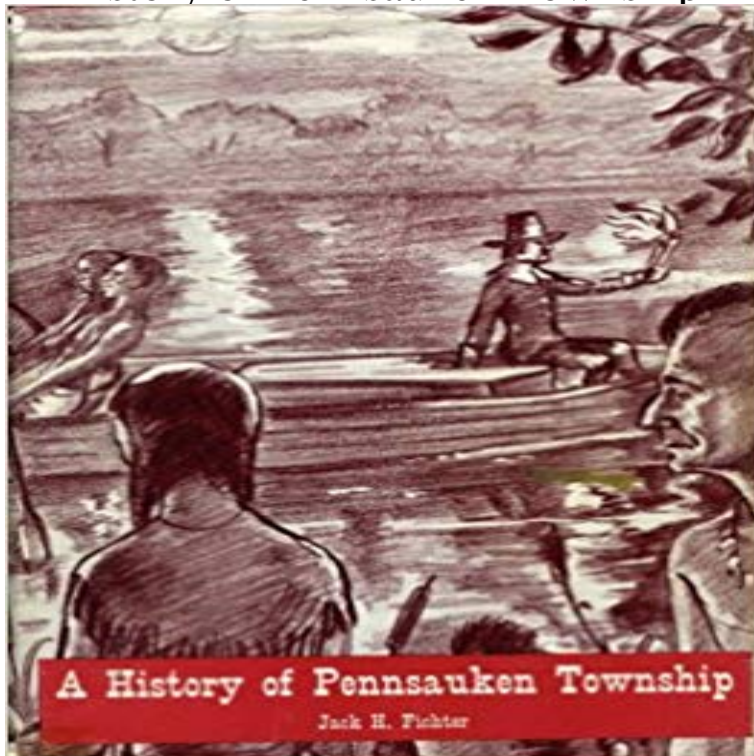


## A History of Pennsauken Township



This fascinating history traces the development of Pennsauken Township from the early Indian civilizations to its importance in a modern world. Pennsauken's story is an adventure of one community, and how it developed its educational, religious, and governmental organizations. A refreshingly different approach has been used to portray the past by giving the reader a background of the private lives of the early citizens as well as some of those living today. Nearly 150 illustrations, many unpublished before, including forty original sketches, provide the reader with a visual understanding of the text. Older folks can relive the days of yesteryear, while young people will find this book an excellent aid in their school preparations. Jack H. Fichter has been a lifelong resident of Pennsauken. After serving in the U. S. Army in World War II, he entered Elizabethtown College where he was graduated in 1952. He has been teaching history and civics in the Pennsauken Jr. High since 1953 and is historian of the Pennsauken Historical Society. Edmund J. Halber was born in Senheim, Germany and came to the United States at an early age. A resident of Philadelphia, he was graduated from the Tyler School of Fine Arts (Temple) after serving in the Marine Corps in World War II. He has been an art teacher in Pennsauken Jr. High since 1954, and is a free lance artist. Both men have taken graduate courses in their subjects at Temple University.
