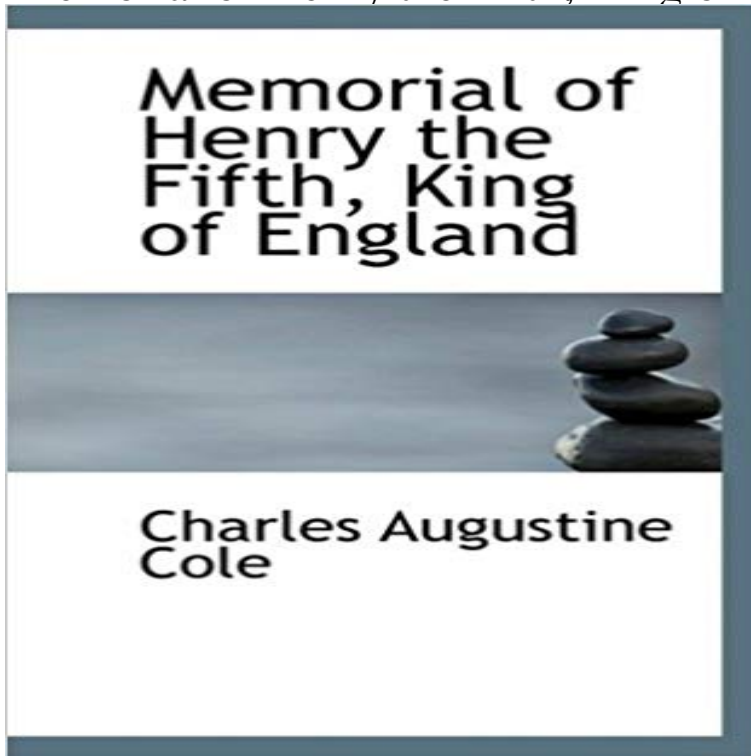


Memorial of Henry the Fifth, King of England
