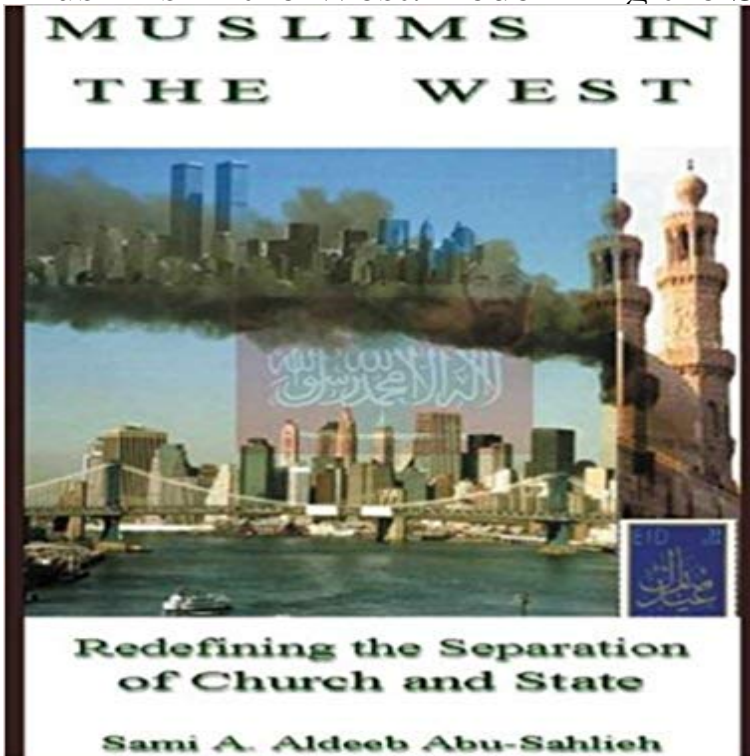


Muslims in the West: Redefining the Separation of Church & State
