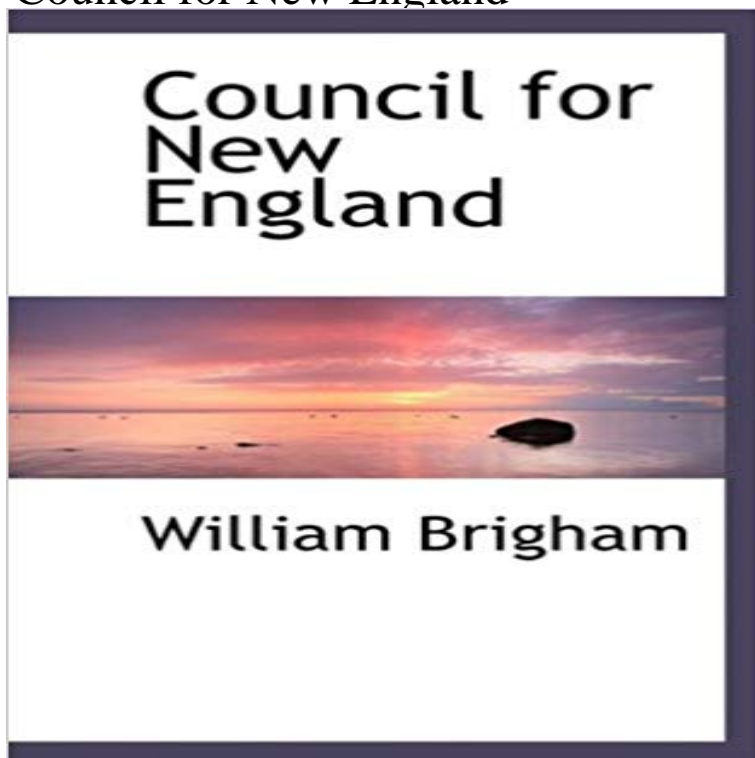


## Council for New England
