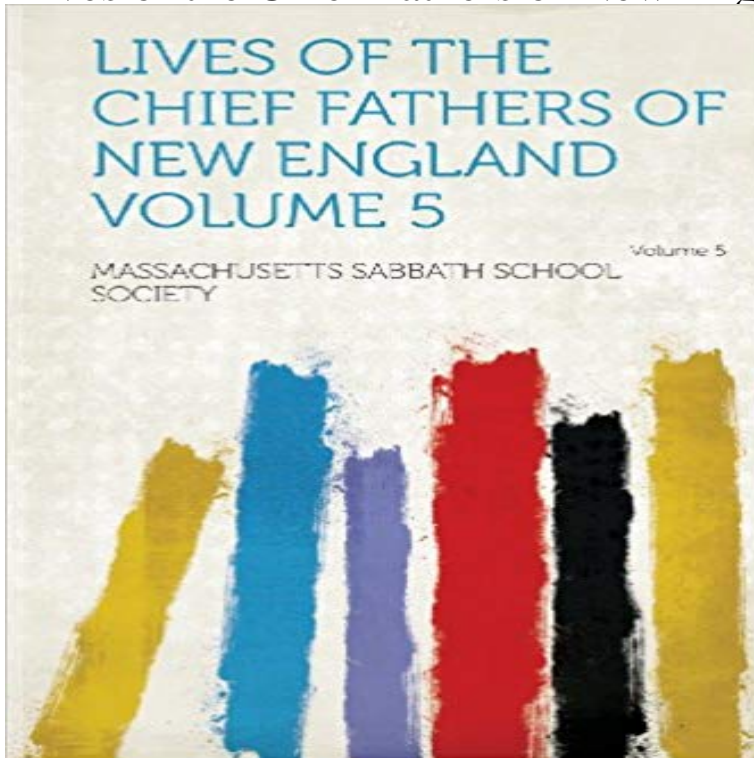


Lives of the Chief Fathers of New England
