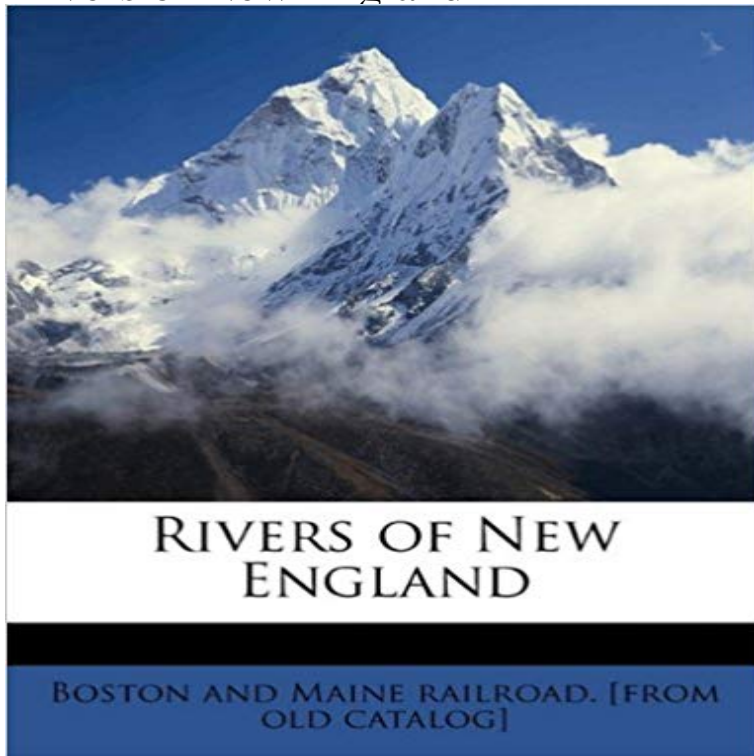


Rivers of New England
