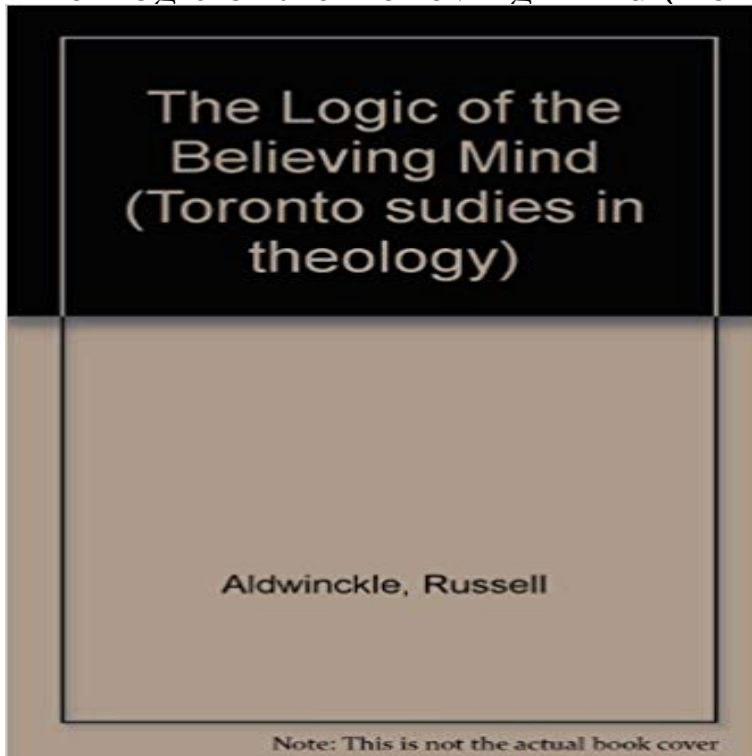


The Logic of the Believing Mind (Toronto Studies in Theology)
