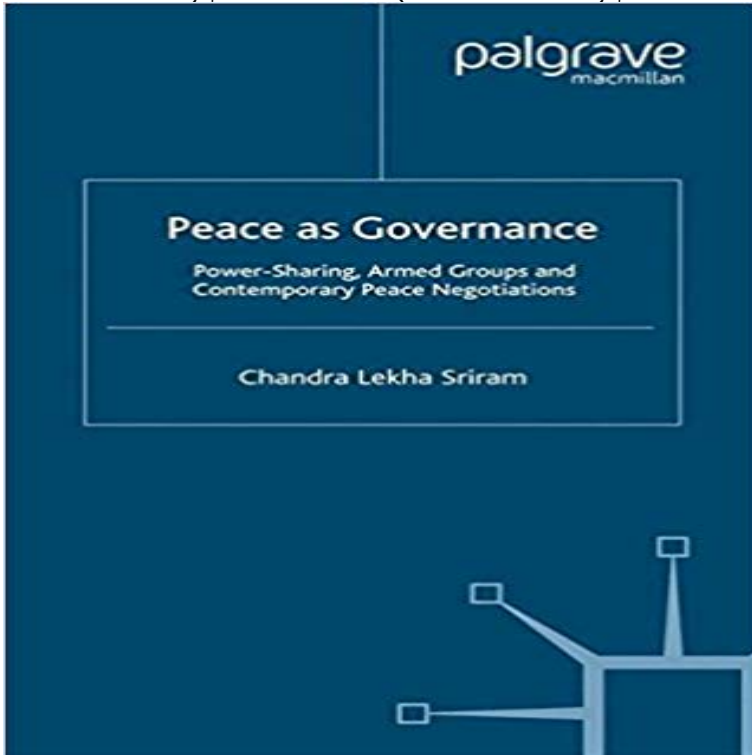


Peace as Governance: Power-Sharing, Armed Groups and Contemporary Peace Negotiations (Rethinking Peace and Conflict Studies)
