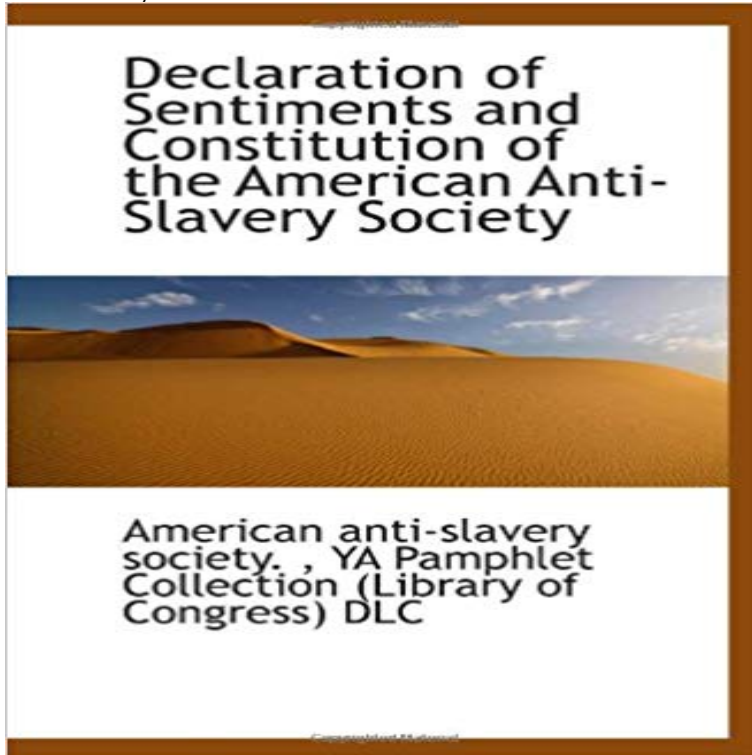


Declaration of Sentiments and Constitution of the American Anti-Slavery Society
