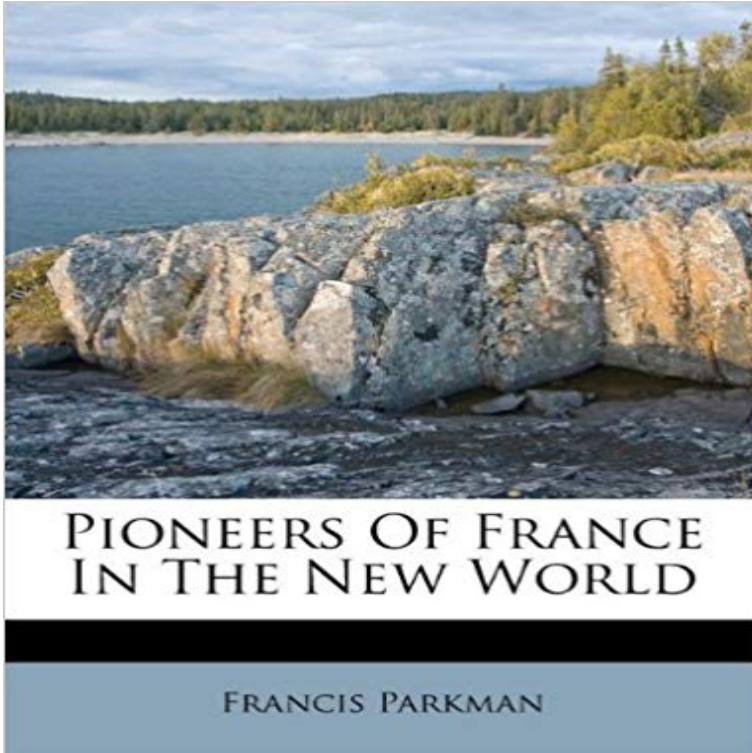


Pioneers Of France In The New World
