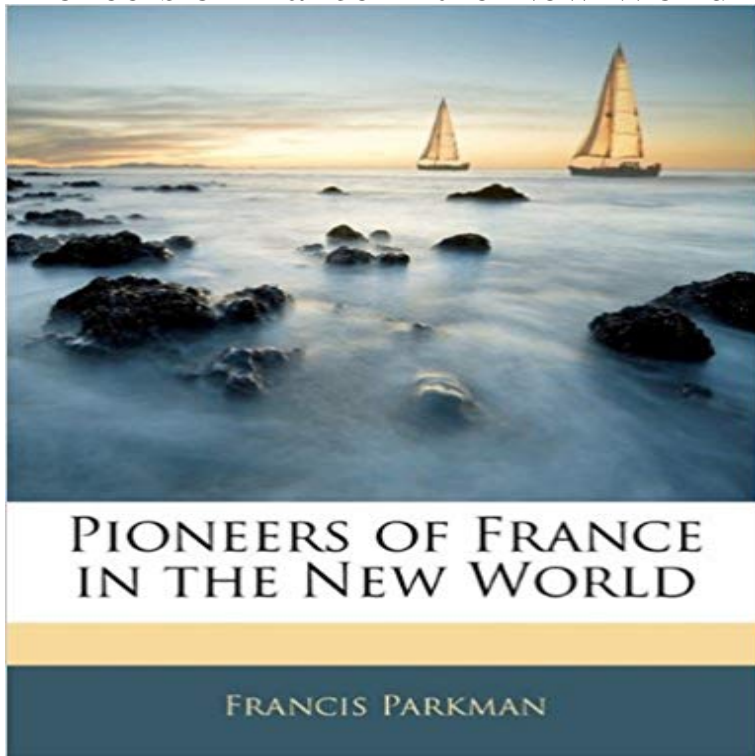


Pioneers of France in the New World
